

Informal Tour FAQs Sheet

“Informal tours” are to help accommodate **high school and college classes** that do not have the means to come to the museum together on a trip or whose numbers are too big for us to accommodate on guided tours. These trips are **unguided** and are intended for students attending on their own or with their families. **Discounted rates apply only to the student.**

These may also be used in the event teachers want to offer **extra credit** for visiting a particular exhibit. Rate will be based on the exhibit desired and our pricing policy for said group.

Rates:

High school classes \$3 per student (an up charge may apply to special exhibitions)

College or University classes \$5 per student (an up charge may apply to special exhibitions)

Scheduling:

Please contact the Curator of Education to confirm that your group qualifies for this opportunity or to schedule your ‘informal tour’.

Informal tours must be scheduled at least one week in advance of the start date. The rate will only be available to students on the class list and only for a two-week timeframe agreed upon by both parties (museum and instructor). ****Students may visit the museum only one (1) time for the discounted rate during the scheduled informal tour period.**

The professor/teacher/principal must provide the following: a class list including contact information for the instructor(s). Students will need to obtain their tickets from the Midland Center for the Arts Ticket Office.

Exceptions can not be made to accommodate students that show up without a class list on file or whom are omitted from the provided class list...please make arrangements with the Museum education department prior to informing your students of this opportunity.
