

MAESTRO WANNABE: FOOD FOR MUSIC – frequently-asked questions

Q: What is Maestro Wannabe: Food for Music?

A: Maestro Wannabe: Food for Music is an entertaining and creative way for the community to raise money for Midland Symphony Orchestra. It's our biggest fundraiser of the year, and an easy way for our community to help the MSO fulfill its mission: "Providing excellence in symphonic music, education and outreach programs for Midland and the mid-Michigan community." Last year's Maestro Wannabe fundraiser raised over \$10,000!

Q: How does the MSO earn money through Maestro Wannabe: Food for Music?

A: Each restaurant will donate to the MSO a percentage of their Wednesday night dinner proceeds, including menu items and all beverages. Also, takeout orders are included, as long as the order is placed after the start of that restaurant's dinner service: **Molly's Bistro** (5:30 pm); **Gengi's** (5:00 pm); **Pi's Chinese Restaurant** (5:00 pm); and **The H Hotel Restaurants** (**Café Zinc** – 5:00 pm; **The Table** – 5:30 pm; **Oxygen** – 4 pm). **There is NO additional charge to the customer!**

Q: Do I need to provide a coupon or mention the MSO when I pay my bill?

A: Not at all! The participating restaurants have agreed to donate a percentage of their Wednesday night proceeds, simple as that. What could be easier?!
