Dow Museum of Science and Art is featured in the Museum School **Faculty and Student Exhibition 2011** currently on display at Midland Center for the Arts, 1801 W. St. Andrews Rd., Midland, MI. The Faculty of the Museum School is featured with recent works to reveal the creativity of the professionals who provide instruction year round in the art department of the Midland Center for the Arts. The students who have taken classes are also provided an opportunity to showcase their creations developed from concepts and techniques taught in the classes.

The exhibition runs July 30 through September 11. Tickets are \$8 adult and \$5 student; FREE to Museum members. Ticket price includes admission to all Museum exhibits, including *It's A Gas! The Bright Side of Science*, on display through September 18, and the interactive Hall of Ideas.

There will be a reception held on August 6, from 7 pm to 9 pm in conjunction with the opening of 2 other exhibitions: Michigan Silversmith Guild: 2011 Jewelry and Objects Exhibition and Marco Lorenzetti Photographs: The Mortician's Grandson along with the Alden B. Dow Museum Annual Volunteer Recognition Awards, as well as award presentations for artistic excellence for the Student exhibition and for exceptional works in the Silversmith Guild exhibition. The reception is free and open to the public and light refreshments will be served.

The Alden B. Dow Museum of Science and Art (ABDM) celebrates discovery, creativity and individual expression through art, science and the interplay between them. Exhibitions in the Museum, classes at the Museum School, multiple outreach programs, a permanent collection and various special events are all components in the ABDM programming.
