MIDLAND – Area residents have a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to improve their vocal stage presence when international singer and musician Elisabeth von Trapp (granddaughter of the legendary von Trapp family from *The Sound of Music*) critiques vocal presentation and technique during masterclasses at Midland Center for the Arts. The Auditorium stage will sing with music during workshops scheduled for two age groups: 12- to 17-year-olds (October 25, from 4 pm to 6 pm) and ages 18 and older (October 27, from 5 pm to 7 pm). Students must prepare a song (not to exceed 3 minutes in length) and bring sheet music for the provided accompanist. Elisabeth will work with each student as time allows to refine their presentation. Students will receive a DVD from the workshop and a certificate of participation. Guests may view the workshop for a \$5 attendance fee.
