MIDLAND, Michigan – Midland Center for the Arts, 1801 West Saint Andrews Road, Midland, Michigan, will be **closed from Saturday, December 24, 2011, through Monday, January 2, 2012**. The closing is an effort to reduce costs and allocate resources based on usage, which historically has been low during this time period. Normal building and Ticket Office hours will resume on Tuesday, January 3, 2012.
